 - 100 meters TOO LOW
 - 50 meters DSQ

A/C on safety frequency all the time.

Positive contact with CJ (SC 6 P1, 3.5.1.7)

- Chief Judge will call "Number X, radio check"
- Pilot respond "Number X, read you X"

 - 3. + selection (by drawing) of 2 additional teams HUN, NED, BEL, GRE, AUS, ITA
 - 4. Drawing of figure selection order
 - 5. Figures selection in drawn order
 - 6. Protests must be submitted 30 minutes after drawing of figures completion.
- Free Unknowns sequence proposals submission to sequence@wac2022.pl
 - OpenAero or VISIO file ... no sequence string, no PDF, no hand drawing
 - Proper naming of the file (ie. POL_U1.seq or POL_Unknown1.seq or POL_Program2.seq)
 - Filled all form details Class, Rules, Category, Program, Positioning, Contest, Date and Figure letters!





Meteo Forecast








Synop - 03.08.2022, 0600 UTC
